Presentation by Mark Sauser, Chief of Stream Habitat Management for PFBC

Mark gave a presentation on the various functions of his department and what all they do in their role of stream habitat improvement. Thanks to Mark for a very informative talk.

Doggie Day Care Development

Eric Oliver gave an update on the doggie daycare development. Eric and Gary Miller read through the plan and found some issues which will be forwarded to the engineer and the township. Doug Brown, from Antis Township, called Eric and said that these concerns did not make it on December's agenda but they have taken them into consideration to be addressed at the January meeting.

Baker Lane

Eric gave an update on the Baker Lane washout project status. Al Budinsky, who is the engineer working with Angie, finally got the approval from the County Conservation District and is putting together the GP1 and is hoping to get it in to DEP and the Fish Commission by the end of January. By the time the permitting gets through it will probably be a June start.

Widening of Route 453

Eric talked to surveyors and Snyder Township supervisors and was informed that Route 453 will be widened to three or four lanes from the Interstate to the substation. It has not been determined what substation they are referring to. Their plan is to start on the mountain this summer and will work in Tyrone the following year. They then will work from interstate 99 toward the Grier School probably in year three of the project. Eric will keep us up to date as he receives more information.

With no other business to be discussed a motion for adjournment was made and carried by unanimous consent. The ending time was 8:20 PM.
